

VIDEO ORAL ARGUMENT

On May 9, 2006, the Court conducted video oral arguments in two cases, Aldana-Chiles v. Florida Unemployment Appeals Commission and Sterling v. Florida Unemployment Appeals Commission. The Appellants argued their cases in the courtroom in Miami. The Appellee argued via video from a conference room in the Office of the State Court Administrator in Tallahassee. The procedure received positive reviews from the participants.

Hereafter the option will be available to Tallahassee counsel to argue via video if they wish. Advance arrangements must be made through the clerk's office.

The Court is working toward a similar arrangement for Key West.
