

VIDEO ORAL ARGUMENT

On June 27, 2006, the Court conducted video oral arguments in two cases, Ellington v. 16th Judicial Circuit of Florida, and Atlantic Shores Resort, LLC v. 507 South Street Corporation, and City of Key West. In Ellington, the Appellant argued from a courtroom in Key West, while the Appellee argued in the Third District courtroom in Miami. In Atlantic Shores, all parties argued from Key West. The procedure received positive reviews from the participants.

Hereafter the option will be available to Key West counsel to argue via video if they wish. Advance arrangements must be made through the clerk's office.
