Petitioner has filed a petition seeking review of the trial court's determination that certain public records (or portions thereof) requested by petitioner are confidential or otherwise exempt from disclosure under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes or Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420.

In light of the fact that the records described in the petition were presented *in camera* to the trial court, and in order for this Court to adequately review the trial court's determination that said records, or portions thereof, are confidential or otherwise exempt from disclosure, respondent is directed to file under seal, within twenty days from this order and in compliance with Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420:

1. A copy of all records and documents provided to the trial court for its *in camera* review.

2. A copy of any records (redacted) which have been provided to petitioner in response to the public records request. If no records have been provided to petitioner, respondent shall so indicate in its notice of filing.


3. A copy of any records (redacted) which respondent intends to provide to petitioner consistent with, and as a result of, the trial court's in camera review and subsequent order.

The records and documents which were provided in camera shall be maintained under seal by the Clerk and shall be treated as confidential by the parties, their counsel, and this Court during the pendency of these appellate proceedings.

Pursuant to Rule 2.420(g)(3), this order shall operate to make these same records and documents confidential in the lower tribunal during the pendency of these appellate proceedings.

Within ten days following entry of this order, the Clerk of this Court shall post, as a docket entry on the Court's online docket, a Notice of Entry of Order directing respondent to file records and documents under seal for this case.
