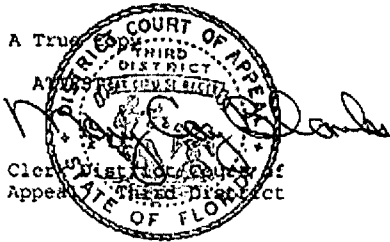
Upon review of appellee's motion to determine confidentiality of court records and for seal order, the Court determines that, pursuant to Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9), a showing has been made that the documents described in the motion should be designated as confidential, maintained under seal, and their confidentiality maintained.

The documents contained in the appendix at pages thirteen through forty-seven, as well as Volumes One, Two and Three of the record, shall be designated as confidential and shall be maintained under seal by the Clerk. Counsel for the parties shall have access to these documents. The documents shall be treated as confidential by the parties, their counsel, and this Court during the pendency of these appellate proceedings.

Pursuant to Rule 2.420(g)(3), this order shall operate to make these same documents confidential in the lower tribunal during the pendency of these appellate proceedings.

Within ten days following entry of this order, the Clerk of this Court shall post, as a docket entry on the Court's online docket, a Notice of Entry of Order granting appellee's motion to determine confidentiality of court records and for seal order.
